

TechPB BST WorkSheet- The purpose of this worksheet is to prevent the members of TechPB from being ripped off by fraudulent / irresponsible traders. I have been using BST on public forums for years, and every time I followed this procedure, the transaction went smoothly. When I didn't follow these steps, my chances of being ripped off raised considerably. I suggest you print this form out, and fill it out ENTIRELY before purchasing an item, selling an item, or trading an item. Please see second page for additional notes.

Transaction Notes-

Do not leave anything to chance. You must get in writing every detail of the deal before initiating the trade. What accessories are included? How recent is that picture? Does the gun work? When was it chrono'd last? What about the box, original parts, manual, packaging? Do the eyes work? Is anything stripped, missing, loose, chipped, scratched, or damaged or broken? Are you the original owner? Why are you selling it?

One of the MOST IMPORTANT statements that both parties must state is the "delivery contract". Without the "delivery contract", you cannot report your property stolen. For instance-

Mike Phillips is trading his Ion to Willie Galarza, for a Lasoya Bushmaster. Mike Phillips is shipping first-

Dear Willie Galarza-

I am ready to initiate this trade. I need you to reply back your delivery contract for my records. Please respond with "I, Willie Galarza, will ship the Lasoya Bushmaster within 3 days of receiving your Ion"

Dear Mike Phillips-

Here is my delivery contract-

"I, Willie Galarza, will ship the Lasoya Bushmaster within 3 days of receiving your Ion"

Thank you-

Willie Galarza

You cannot prove “intent to steal” in a court of law, without breach of contract. If you do not get this statement from the trader IN WRITING, they can hold on to your property INDEFINITELY, and simply claim “Yes, I am just running late shipping it out, I just forgot.”. Do not ship property without entering into a delivery contract.

Tips for selling your items-

Title-

“leet” or “agg” titles don’t get noticed, and you won’t get shit for your items. A nice, clear description is what potential buyers are looking for. Do you want your seller’s to think you are a idiot kid? Or a mature responsible trader who respects people’s time and money?

For instance-

Dust Black Bob Long Vice FS/FT \$600 Shipped (good)

>>>> ____5up3r 51CK n457Y 8U7753cK2 808 L0n9 v1C3 CH3ck 17 0U7!! ____<<<< (bad)

Be mature, be respectful, and honesty is the best policy, protect yourself and protect your feedback, disclose everything you feel is important or could affect someone’s opinion on the trade.

Note 1: Do not ship to PO BOX under any circumstances! Only ship to a physical address and verify address with map.google.com. PO BOX’s can be registered to anyone or anything, with no ID verification!

Note 2: You must always have TWO methods of telephone contact. If they refuse to give two, DO NOT TRADE WITH THAT PERSON! Many scam artists purchase pre-paid cell phones that expire after they get your property!

Note 3- If under 18, be VERY careful, The parent’s are ultimately responsible for the actions of the minor, you’re best to deal directly with them. Under most laws, minors cannot be contractually obligated under any circumstances. Meaning, if you ship your \$1800 SL94 to a minor, there is no law that says they have to ship anything back, nor can they be found guilty of theft or breach of contract. Deal directly with the parents, enter into agreement with the parents. Also, if they do not possess a drives license, how are they going to bring the items to the post office? No car = no ride to post office, don’t say we didn’t warn you!
